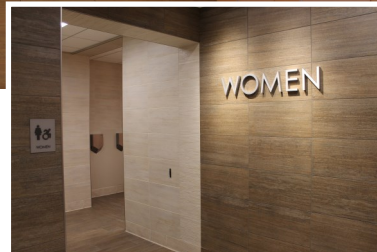

Pathfinder has completed Phase I of ongoing renovations to the Greater Rochester International Airport public restroom facilities. Each restroom module consists of multi-user men's and women's rooms as well as family restrooms and utility spaces. A quiet area for nursing mothers is also provided. Two modules have been completed to date and Phase II is currently in construction. Over the course of the next year, the remainder of restrooms throughout the concourse will be renovated.

The project scope involved a complete renovation of the existing restrooms including walls, ceilings and terrazzo flooring. Pathfinder reviewed plumbing fixture counts throughout the airport in addition to a building code review for the project area.

Updated finishes were extensively reviewed with the client to select materials and colors that will be durable, low maintenance and stylish for many years. Ceramic tile walls and floors, quartz countertops and graffiti resistant toilet stalls are some of the features that will be and solid surface wall finishes. Transition to existing finishes within the concourse was an important consideration as well.

Signage was included in the project scope and Pathfinder also assisted with furniture selection for the nursing area.
